



## **WILTON HEALTH OFFICER UPDATE ON COVID 19 JANUARY 15, 2021**

### **Wilton Coronavirus cases double since Christmas**

The number of COVID-19 cases reported since the Christmas period have doubled and now stand at 108 with 15 active cases.

The State is updating its vaccine plan due to the rise in Coronavirus cases across New Hampshire. They plan to make vaccines available to anyone age 65 or older under what is called 'Phase 1B.' The overriding factor to carry this out sooner than anticipated is that statistics show that 95% of the deaths from COVID-19 are in that age group.

Starting January 22nd, residents 65 and older can go to [VACCINES.NH.GOV](https://vaccines.nh.gov) and register to have the inoculation.

Our Emergency Management Director reminded us that the easiest way to remember how to combat this virus is MW6.....Mask up, Wash your hands and remain 6 feet apart.
