



WILTON HEALTH OFFICER UPDATE ON COVID 19 JANUARY 22, 2021

Wilton Coronavirus cases still on the rise

We continue to experience an increase in community level transmission of COVID-19 in Wilton. In the past week, we have seen 10 new cases of the Coronavirus mostly attributed to gatherings. There are 118 cases that have been reported to the State of which 8 are currently sick or in isolation.

Beginning today at 8:00 am Wilton residents 65 and older are able to sign on to the State website at [VACCINES.NH.GOV](https://vaccines.nh.gov) to register for their vaccination. The other option is to call 211 to speak with a representative.

It should only take about five minutes to answer some medial questions and when confirmed you will receive an email within five business days informing you of the State-managed COVID -19 Vaccination Clinic fixed site for the inoculation and be able to schedule your appointment.
