Though it might feel like we have little control, especially with the new strain of COVID 19 hitting the United States, there are still rudimentary steps to follow to ensure that all safety and sanitary actions are taken.

WASH HANDS---STAY INSIDE---COVER YOUR MOUTH.

The increase in Coronavirus cases in Wilton is alarming. Five days before Christmas we reported 56 cases of which at that time 16 were active. Today we are reporting 96 cases of which 26 are active. **That is a 62% increase in active cases.** This illustrates what can happen over a holiday period.

There is no one source of the spread, but it can be associated with gatherings which are why a number of businesses in Wilton are now closed for walk-in traffic (although curbside pick-up may be available). People tend to forget that the virus is not only transmitted through droplets but also on surfaces that have not been sanitized. **DO NOT TOUCH YOUR FACE EYES OR NOSE WITH UNWASHED HANDS.**
