Spring is fast approaching which always seems to lead right into warm weather and sunny skies. March is the month we all blossom with inspiration, motivation and enthusiasm to expend all that accumulated energy. At this point we are now ready for the projects that have been planned and waiting for better weather to come about.

A few brief reminders to facilitate your recycling center visit:

- If you have items other than household trash and recyclables, please ask where they need
 to be deposited. Fees apply to scale transactions plus items/bags deposited into the landfill
 containers (except kitty litter). There are also other fee-based items. We only accept checks
 or cash at the present time. Fees must be paid at the time of your visit. Please do not
 hesitate to ask for advice on disposal practices.
- All trash needs to be in closed bags. The trash is transferred inside the building therefore loose garbage is a health hazardous to us. Thank you for your cooperation on this issue.
- Paper goods: Corrugated Cardboard has ridges remember "Ruffles has ridges" so does corrugated cardboard! Mixed paper consists of assorted containers that are not corrugated or newsprint. For shredded paper, please use a paper bag in the shredder, and when full "tape" it closed and recycle the full bag into the mixed paper. Newsprint/Magazines are collected together at the present.
- Plastics: #1 is clear or see-through and bottles only. The neck of the container is smaller than the bottom. #2 containers are solid or nearly solid color. "Milk" jugs are translucent but this includes other containers that are translucent too.
- Aluminum: these are aluminum beverage cans ONLY. Steel cans also include all other aluminum containers. Glass: remember bottles and jars ONLY. All other glass needs to be deposited into the landfill.
- Remember any recyclable containers are related to food or light cleaning (non-hazardous)
 containers. Please remember caps off and to rinse all containers. We second sort and
 handle these containers which can be hazardous (Clorox), plus rinsing will also help control
 pests/insects and odors.
- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to closing to allow enough time to upload your items.

Note that Household Hazardous Waste collection is scheduled for **Saturday June 27**, **2020**. More information will be available and posted shortly.

The restroom at the recycling center will be permanently closed to the public effective immediately. This has been a privilege in the past but due to the current health concerns as well as the risk to the employees, we will no longer provide a public bathroom. Please take care of your needs before your visit the recycling center and bring hand sanitizer to clean your hands
