New to Wilton from Out of State

Welcome to Wilton! Vehicle registrations and drivers licensing should be processed within 60 days of moving to NH. Vehicle registrations are completed at the Town Clerk's Office.

NH requires titles for all vehicles 2000 or newer and for all trailers 2000 or newer and weighing 3001 lbs. or more. Along with the title we need the current odometer reading. If two owners are named, two signatures are needed on the NH title application, so both owners need to be present to sign the paperwork.

If there is a lienholder on the vehicle, you will not have a title. Please bring your lienholder information with you as we will need to include that information on your new title application.

If the vehicle is 2000 or newer and there is no lienholder, the applicant must have a title to register the vehicle in NH. Model year 1999 vehicles and older require a bill of sale, out of state registration or title and possibly a vehicle identification verification form to be completed. Ask for more details.

New NH residents can obtain their NH driver's license at the NH Department of Motor Vehicles. Please refer to the NH Department of Safety, Division of Motor Vehicles website for more information on driver licensing and a list of what documentation to bring with you.

Drivers aged 16 and 17 years need to have a Parental Consent form completed by a parent/guardian or their insurance company before every registration is completed.

You can register to vote at the Town Clerk's Office any time prior to 10 days before an election. Voter registration can also be completed at the polls on Election Day. For all elections, our polling place is open 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Absentee ballots are available at the Town Clerk's Office.

Dogs are required to be licensed by April 30th every year. Proof of rabies vaccination is required. Cats do not need to be licensed!

Trash: Wilton is one of the first towns in the country to require mandatory recycling. A detailed flyer is available at the Recycling Center, on our website or at the Town Hall. A permit (sticker) is now required in order to use the Recycling Center. Stickers can be obtained at the Recycling Center.
