#### ARTICLE VI

#### Hawkers, Peddlers and Vendors

#### 200-40. Hawkers, Peddlers and Vendors; License Required

#### I. Definitions:

For the purpose of this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

HAWKERS, PEDDLERS AND VENDORS - Include any itinerant vendors, hawkers, peddlers, traders, farmers, merchants, or other persons who sell, offer to sell, or take orders for merchandise from temporary or transient sales locations within a town or who go from town to town or place to place within a town for such purposes.

#### II. License required:

No hawker, peddler or vendor shall take orders for, sell or barter, carry for sale or barter or exposing therefore, any goods, wares, or merchandise, unless he/she holds a valid license issued by the Police Department to do so.

#### III. License application; fee:

Applications for said licenses can be picked up during normal business hours at the Police Department. The fee for the license shall be fifty dollars (\$50.). This fee may be waived at the discretion of the Chief of Police and will be valid for one (1) year.

#### IV. Prohibited hours of business; exempt organizations

Hawkers, peddlers and vendors shall not sell, barter, display or conduct business during the hours of 7:00 am. and 5:00 pm on any national, state or town-designated holiday.

Locally based nonprofit organizations (i.e., Boy/Girl Scouts, Rotary, Lions, schools, etc.) will be exempt from this ordinance. A candidate for public office in the process of obtaining signatures on nomination papers, who seeks to have the candidate's name placed on the ballot for the state general election by submitting nomination papers, is also exempt from this ordinance.

#### V. Exhibit of license

Every person licensed under this chapter will exhibit said license when requested by any police officer or to the person to whom he exposes his goods, wares or merchandise, and, if he/she fails to do so, he/she shall be liable to the same penalty as if he/she had no license.

#### VI. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates this Article shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the first offense and not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for any subsequent offense that occurs within a twelve-month period following a conviction for a first offense.
